Virginia Care Partners and UnitedHealthcare to Improve Patients' Care in the Greater Richmond Area

- *Accountable care collaboration to enhance how the health system cares for patients*
- *Innovative physician-directed network focused on collaborative care delivery*

RICHMOND, Va. (March 31, 2016) – Virginia Care Partners (VCP) and UnitedHealthcare have launched an accountable care program to improve people's health and their satisfaction with their health care experience.

The new accountable care program will dedicate more resources to care coordination and make it easier to share important health information. As a result, VCP member hospitals and physicians will share in savings generated through providing care under a value-based, patient-centric care model focused on keeping people healthy.

More than 18,000 people enrolled in UnitedHealthcare's employer-sponsored health plans are eligible to benefit from this collaboration.

Many people who have gone to the doctor or hospital – particularly those with complex or chronic illnesses – have found they often have to connect information from each of their doctor's visits themselves, and have sometimes received duplicative tests or care that isn't coordinated.

Through this collaboration, UnitedHealthcare and VCP will work together to better coordinate patients' care, using shared technology, timely data and information about emergency room visits and hospital admissions. This partnership will also provide services to help patients manage their chronic health conditions by enhancing relationships with their personal physicians and encouraging healthy lifestyles.

VCP was formed in 2012 by physicians committed to improving their patients' health outcomes by applying best treatment practices across all care settings – in physician offices, hospitals and outpatient-care settings. VCP works collaboratively to establish value-based care partnerships that provide incentives for improved patient outcomes, adherence to care standards, increased preventive care and chronic disease management, and reduced cost.

“Our multispecialty physician leadership and population health analytics have given network practices the ability to increase quality and efficiency while reducing redundancy and health care costs,” said Dr. Amar Shah, primary care physician with Prime Care Family Practice, a VCP group. “We are enhancing care coordination across care settings, and our partnership with UnitedHealthcare enables the network to provide improved care to more patients in our community.”

The primary care doctors and specialists who comprise the physician-led network work with VCP registered nurse care managers to assist patients in transitioning from hospital to home. The nurse care managers visit patients in the hospital before they are discharged to ensure that they understand their diagnosis and discharge orders and to help them schedule follow-up appointments. They notify the patient’s primary care physician and send discharge summary, orders and medication lists to the practice. They follow up with patients once they are home to answer questions, help them better understand their health care issues and needs, and alert care providers about any complications or issues. When needed, they work with the primary care physician to integrate behavioral health services.

The Transitions of Care clinical team includes nurse care managers and a licensed clinical social worker, clinical pharmacist and registered dietitian. VCP is working to improve patient health and satisfaction through increased coordination, sharing of medical documentation and clinical support for patients

“UnitedHealthcare and VCP are working together to help people receive more personalized and better connected care, which will significantly enhance people’s ability to live healthier lives,” said Christopher J. Mullins of UnitedHealthcare.
